Applications are invited for admission to Doctoral Degree Programmes in Agriculture, Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, Forestry and Master's Programme in Agriculture, Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, Forestry and Biotechnology for the session 2010-11 from the residents of Jharkhand State only (Except Doctoral Programmes which is opened to all India citizens). The candidates of other states who have Graduated from this University can also apply. Prescribed Application Forms and prospectus can be had from the Office of the Registrar, Birsa Agricultural University, Kanke, Ranchi-834006 on payment of Rs. 400/- for General/ BC-I/BC-II and Rs. 100/- for ST/SC candidates in the Form of Bank Draft only from Nationalized Bank, payable to the Comptroller, Birsa Agricultural University, Kanke, Ranchi-834006. The Application Forms and prospectus can be obtained from 09.08.2010 to 08.09.2010 in person during office hours and up to 01.09.2010 by registered Post.

The candidates desirous for admission may apply up to three subjects in one Application Form. Separate Application Form should be used for more than three subjects. Results awaited candidates can also apply but they are required to submit semester report from 1st to the last semester along with Application Form for preparation of merit list. Provisional Degree Certificate (PDC) and Transcript must be submitted at the time of counseling followed admission. Reservation in admission will be made as per State Government Rules. The last date for submission of Application Forms is 08.09.2010. Application Form can be down loaded from website <http://www.baujharkhand.org> & can be submitted alongwith cost of application and processing fee in the form of Bank Draft, payable to the Comptroller, Birsa Agricultural University, Kanke, Ranchi – 834006.

Applications are invited in prescribed forms from the candidates desirous for admission to Post-Graduate Programme in Agriculture, Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, Forestry, and Biotechnology of Birsa Agricultural University as detailed below for the Session 2010-11.

I. Doctoral Programme

A. Agriculture:

B. Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry

(1) Animal Breeding & Genetics (2) Animal Husbandry Extension Education (3) Live Stock Production & Management (4) Veterinary Biochemistry (5) Veterinary Gynaecology & Obstetrics (6) Veterinary Pathology (7) Veterinary Pharmacology & Toxicology (8) Veterinary Physiology.

C. Forestry

(1) Silviculture & Agro-Forestry

Eligibility criteria

- (a) Bachelor's Degree in Agriculture/ Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry/ Forestry.
- (b) Minimum overall grade point average (O.G.P.A.) 6.00/10 or 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent percentage of marks at Master's degree level. A candidate can apply for Doctoral Programme only in the Major subject of study at Master's level.
- (c) Merit list will be prepared in 10 point scale on the basis of OGPA (Overall Grade Point Average) earned by the candidate at Master's degree level.
- (d) The requirement of percentage of marks may be relaxed to the extent of 5% for such candidates who have published original research papers in standard scientific journals.
- (e) Candidates appearing in final year exams can also apply but he/she must submit required certificates at the time of counseling followed by admission.

II. Master's Programme

A. Agriculture :

(1) Agricultural Entomology (2) Agricultural Extension Education (3) Agricultural Physics & Meteorology (4) Agricultural Statistics (5) Agronomy (6) Horticulture (7) Mycology & Plant Pathology (8) Plant Breeding & Genetics (9) Soil Science & Agricultural Chemistry.

B. Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry

(1) Animal Breeding & Genetics (2) Animal Husbandry Extension Education (3) Live Stock Production & Management (4) Veterinary Biochemistry (5) Veterinary Gynaecology & Obstetrics (6) Veterinary Medicine (7) Veterinary Parasitology (8) Veterinary Pathology (9) Veterinary Pharmacology & Toxicology (10) Veterinary Physiology (11) Veterinary Public Health & Epidemiology (12) Veterinary Surgery & Radiology.

C. Forestry

(1) Basic Science & Humanities, (2) Forest Products & Utilization, (3) Natural Resources Management & (4) Silviculture & Agro-Forestry.

D. Biotechnology

(i) Biotechnology (Hons.) Stream (ii) Agriculture (iii) Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry (iv) Forestry.

Eligibility Criteria :

(i) Bachelor's Degree in Agriculture (4 years course), Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry (5 Years course) and Forestry (4 years course) for admission to M.Sc. (Ag.), M.V. Sc. and M.Sc. (Forestry) Programme respectively. However, for admission to M.Sc. (Biotech), B.Sc. (Hons.) in Biotechnology is essential.

(ii) Minimum Overall Grade Point Average (O.G.P.A.) and Subject Grade Point Average (S.G.P.A.) 6.00/00 or 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent percentage of marks in aggregate at Bachelor's Degree level for General and BC-I/BC-II candidates and for SC/ST candidates 5.50/10.00 O.G.P.A. /S.G.P.A. or equivalent percentage of marks is required.

(iii) The merit list will be prepared on the basis of S.G.P.A. (Subject Grade Point Average) obtained by the candidate in the subject in which he /she desires to seek admission. Subject means both core and elective courses studied by the candidate in that particular subject. The merit list will be prepared in 10 point scale.

(iv) For admission in M.Sc. (Forestry) and in Biotechnology from Agriculture / Veterinary Science/ Forestry stream, only O.G.P.A. will be considered. However, for Biotechnology (Hons.) graduates percentage of marks in Biotechnology component only at graduation level will be considered for admission in Master's Programme in Biotechnology.

(v) Candidates appearing in final year exams can also apply but he /she must submit required certificates at the time of counseling which will follow admission.

III Residential requirements :

For admission to Master's Programme to each discipline, residential requirement for Jharkhand State as specified below is essential, While the seats of Doctoral Programme are open to all eligible candidate and the residential requirement is not necessary. The applications for admission in Master's Degree Programme shall have to append a residential certificate as detailed below to qualify the requirement of admission.

vi Such candidates who have not studied in Jharkhand but claim eligibility on ground of permanent / 10 years continuous residence in Jharkhand in respect of their parents, in addition to the above certificate must also furnish a certificate for the qualifying examination indicating the permanent address as recorded in the Admission Register of the Institution. - IV Reservation of seats will be in accordance with the Jharkhand Govt. Policy and will be followed in alphabetical cyclic orders of the P.G. Department in Agriculture, Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, Forestry and Biotechnology. The details of seats are given at Annexure - I.
- V. The S.G.P.A. (subject grade point average) from different grading system will be converted into 10 point scale.
- VI. The candidates who have graduated in Agril. / Vety. Sci. & A.H./ Forestry from SAUs/ CAUs/ Deemed Agril./ Vety. University/ Institutions recognized by ICAR shall be considered for admission.
- VII. The Application Forms and Prospectus can be obtained from 09.08.2010 to 08.09.2010 in person during office hours and up to 01.09.2010 by Registered post from the office of the Registrar, Birsa Agricultural University, Kanke, Ranchi – 834006 on payment through Bank Draft from any Nationalized Bank, payable to Comptroller, Birsa Agricultural University, Ranchi – 834006. Cost of Application Form (1) For General / BC-I/BC-II candidate Rs. 400.00 (2) For ST/SC candidate Rs. 100.00 (cost of Application Form paid in any other form will not be accepted.)
- VIII. Application Forms complete in all respect alongwith the following documents should be submitted on or before 08.09.2010 to the office of Registrar, Birsa Agricultural University, Ranchi - 834006.

IX. Documents required

1. Processing Fee of Rs. 100/- only in the form of Bank Draft, payable to the Comptroller, Birsa Agricultural University, Kanke, Ranchi – 834006.
2. Self Addressed and Stamped (Rs. 25) envelope 23x10 cms.
3. Attested Xerox copies of :
 - i. Transcript / Marks sheets of all Examinations.
 - ii. Character Certificate from Head of the institution last attended.
 - iii. Residential Certificate as per clause III.
 - iv. The candidate claiming admission under reserved category must attach a certificate to this effect from the authorities as specified in the application form.
 - v. Any other relevant document.

X Application received late and / or incomplete in any respect shall be rejected.

Note:

1. A candidate can apply to a maximum of three subjects in one Application Form. In case he/she is desirous to apply for more subjects, extra application form is to be used.
2. Application Form can be downloaded from website <http://www.baujharkhand.org> & can be submitted alongwith cost of application and processing fee in the form of Bank Draft, payable to the Comptroller, Birsa Agricultural University, Kanke, Ranchi – 834006.
3. Candidates already in service (other than B.A.U.) must route their application through their employer/ controlling officer alongwith certificate from the later that he/ she will be relieved for entire period of the degree programme as per rule, failing which the candidature of such applicants will be rejected *suo-moto* and no appeal to this effect will be entertained.

THE CANDIDATE SELECTED FOR ADMISSION WILL BE ADMITTED ON PRESCRIBED DATE ONLY AFTER SUBMISSION OF RELIEVING CERTIFICATE FROM THEIR EMPLOYER.
